NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 2021, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Service (Amendment) Rules, 2025.
(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Amendment of Schedule-II.**- In Schedule-II Subordinate Service Posts, appended to the Rajasthan Educational (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 2021, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, after the existing Group D: Computer Wing and entries thereto, the following new Group E: Pre Primary Wing and entries thereto shall be added, namely:-

“Group E: Pre Primary Wing

1.	Senior Pre Primary Teacher	-	100%	-	Pre Primary Teacher Grade-I	Five years' experience on the post mentioned in column number 6.	-
2.	Pre Primary Teacher Grade-I	-	100%	-	Pre Primary Teacher Grade-II	Five years' experience on the post mentioned in column number 6.	-

4.	Pre Primary Teacher	100%	-	Qualifications as prescribed for Pre-School/ Nursery Teacher by the National Council for Teacher Education under the National Council for Teacher Education (Determination of Minimum Qualifications for Persons to be recruited as Education Teachers and Physical Education Teachers in Pre-primary, Primary, Upper Primary, Secondary, Senior Secondary or Intermediate Schools or Colleges) Regulations, 2014, as amended from time to time, or any equivalent qualification with any nomenclature recognized by the NCTE.	-	Persons regularly recruited and appointed on the post of Pre-Primary Education Teacher under the Rajasthan Integrated Child Development (State and Subordinate) Service Rules, 1998 shall deemed to be appointed on the post of Pre Primary Teacher under these rules. 3. **Amendment of Schedule- III.**— In Schedule-III, appended to the said rules, after the existing heading 12. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Lecturer (Special Education) and entries thereto, the following new heading 13 and entries thereto shall be added, namely:-

“13. Scheme and syllabus of competitive examination for the post of Pre Primary Teacher:-

- (1) The examination shall carry 300 marks.
- (2) There shall be one question paper.
- (3) Duration of the question paper shall be 02 hours 30 minutes.
- (4) The question paper shall carry 150 questions. All the questions shall be Multiple Choice Type.
- (5) Negative marking shall be applicable in the evaluation of answers. For every wrong answer, one third of the marks prescribed for that particular question shall be deducted.
Explanation: Wrong answer shall mean an incorrect answer or multiple answers.
- (6) The minimum qualifying marks for paper shall be 40%, Provided that the percentage fixed as above shall be relaxed by 5% for the candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- (7) If the recruitment is meant for English medium schools, the medium of examination shall be English only.
- (8) Subjects included in the question paper are given hereunder.

Syllabus and Scope of the Paper: The syllabus and scope of paper for the examination shall be as prescribed by the Commission/Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be, from time to time and will be intimated to the candidates within the stipulated time in the manner as the Commission/Board/Appointing Authority, as the case may be, deems fit.

(i) Geographical, Historical and Cultural knowledge of Rajasthan, Rajasthani Language	– 100 Marks
(ii) General knowledge of Rajasthan, Educational Scenario, The Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and Current Affairs	– 80 Marks
(iii) Subject matter related with early Childhood Education (Based on Nursery Teacher Training)	–100 Marks
(a) Child Development (from 0 to 6 years)	
(b) Physical Development	
(c) Social and Emotional Development	
(d) Linguistic Development	
(e) Cognitive Development	
(f) Creative Development	
(g) Special Children, Mental health & hygiene	
(h) Learning- Motivation, Interest, Habits & Behavior	
(i) Teaching Learning Process & Methodology	
(j) Assessment & Evaluation of the Achievements of Children.	
(iv) Educational Psychology	– 10 Marks
(v) Information Technology	– 10 Marks.”
